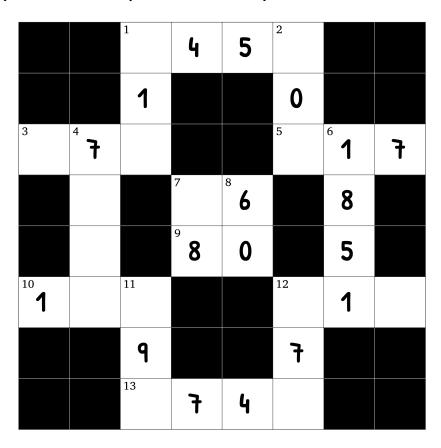


Cross Figure - Beginner Puzzle #26

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 1 A prime number
- **3** Thirty times a prime number
- **5** Rearranged digits of 12 down
- **7** Twice a prime number
- **9** Five times a square
- **10** A prime number
- 12 Twice the result of 13 across minus 4 down
- **13** Fifty-two times a prime number

Down

- 1 10 across minus half of 12 down
- 2 Mean of 3 across and 7 across
- **4** Consecutive digits unordered
- **6** Three times a prime number
- 7 Four-fifths of 8 down
- 8 12 down minus 12 across
- **11** A prime number
- 12 Mean of 7 down and 2 down
