
# **Cross Figure - Beginner Puzzle #30**

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

### **Rules:**

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



#### **Across**

- 2 11 across minus 22 across
- 4 18 down minus 3 down
- **6** A prime number
- **7** Same as 15 across
- **8** 1 down minus 13 down
- 10 3 down divided by 7 across
- **11** Sixty-one times 13 down
- **14** 5 down plus half of 16 across
- **15** 3 down divided by 19 across
- **16** 1 down minus 12 down
- 19 3 down divided by 7 across
- 21 A square
- **22** Seven times a square
- **23** Twice a prime number

#### **Down**

- 1 7 across plus half of 15 down
- **3** 10 across times 15 across
- 5 Nine times a prime number
- **6** Mean of 4 across and 19 across
- 9 Half of 23 across, then subtract 18 down
- **10** Eight times a prime number
- **12** 20 down divided by eighteen
- **13** 21 across divided by ten
- **15** Five times 12 down
- 17 Twice the result of 6 across minus 13 down
- 18 Seventeen times a prime number
- **20** Four-fifths of 21 across
