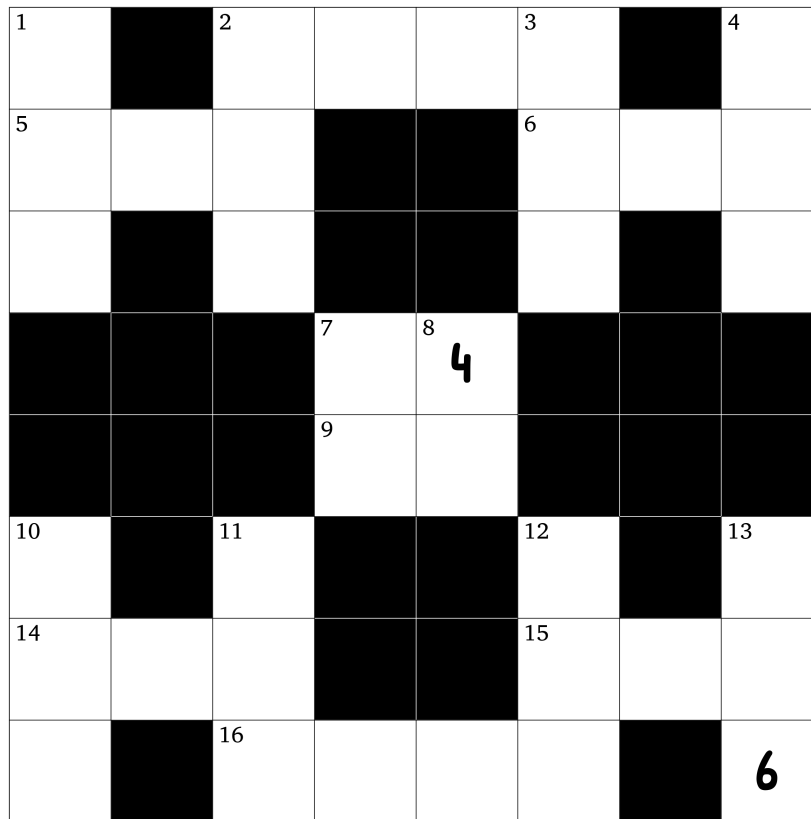


## Cross Figure - Beginner Puzzle #35

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

### Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



### Across

- 16 across plus 13 down
- Three times 12 down
- Mean of 2 down and 4 down
- Twice a prime number
- 3 down minus 6 across
- 5 across minus 8 down
- Fifteen times a prime number
- Twenty-seven times a prime number

### Down

- Mean of 15 across and 12 down
- Thirty times a prime number
- 5 across minus 8 down
- Mean of 2 down and 7 across
- Five times a prime number
- A prime number
- Forty-four times a prime number
- Three-fourths of 10 down
- Rearranged digits of 6 across
- Four times a prime number
