


# **Cross Figure - Beginner Puzzle #39**

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

#### **Rules:**

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



### Across

- 1 Fifty-one times 13 down
- **3** Seven times 13 across
- **6** Mean of 1 down and 11 across
- 7 Mean of 2 down and 1 down
- 8 3 across times 2 down
- **10** Six times a prime number
- **11** 5 down minus 11 down
- **13** 1 across divided by 7 across
- **15** Twelve times a prime number
- 16 4 down times 12 down

### Down

- 1 10 across minus half of 9 down
- **2** 8 down divided by ninety-five
- **4** 11 across divided by three
- **5** 11 down reversed
- 8 15 across plus 11 down
- **9** Twice a prime number
- **11** A square
- **12** A prime number
- **13** Two-fifths of 11 across
- 14 Five times 4 down
