
Difficulty:

Cross Figure - Beginner Puzzle #46

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- **1** Two-thirds of 2 across
- 2 Mean of 12 across and 1 across
- **5** Twice a square
- **6** Twice a prime number
- **8** Six times a prime number
- **9** 3 down minus half of 11 across
- 11 Six times a square
- 12 Mean of 6 across and 13 across
- 13 10 down minus 12 across

Down

- **1** Mean of 5 down and 2 across
- **3** A prime number
- 4 First three digits are the same as 1 down
- **5** Nineteen times a prime number
- 7 4 down divided by 6 across
- **10** Twice a prime number
- **11** Mean of 8 across and 1 across
