


Cross Figure - Beginner Puzzle #46

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- Two-thirds of 2 across
- Mean of 12 across and 1 across
- Twice a square
- Twice a prime number
- Six times a prime number
- 3 down minus half of 11 across
- Six times a square
- Mean of 6 across and 13 across
- 10 down minus 12 across

Down

- Mean of 5 down and 2 across
- A prime number
- First three digits are the same as 1 down
- Nineteen times a prime number
- 4 down divided by 6 across
- Twice a prime number
- Mean of 8 across and 1 across
