### Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.

### Across

- 20 across plus 4 across
- 7 across minus 3 down
- 14 across divided by eight
- Mean of 21 across and 1 across
- A prime number
- Rearranged digits of 11 across
- Four times a prime number
- 17 across plus half of 1 across
- Thirty-three times a square
- 19 across reversed
- 17 across reversed
- All digits are the same
- Two-thirds of 18 down

### Down

- Twice the result of 11 across plus 20 across
- Consecutive digits unordered
- 2 down minus 10 across
- Mean of 10 down and 4 across
- 15 down reversed
- 4 down plus 15 down
- 4 across plus 10 across
- Seven times 3 down
- Rearranged digits of 14 across
- Mean of 14 across and 21 across
- Twice the result of 5 down plus 18 down
- 13 down divided by five
