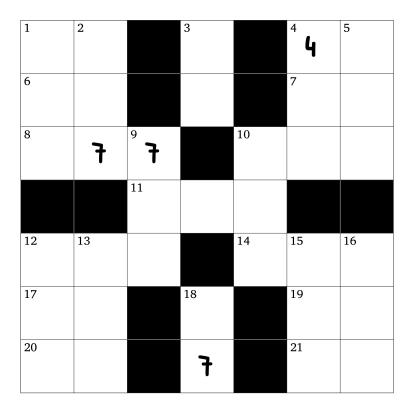
Cross Figure - Beginner Puzzle #48

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 1 20 across plus 4 across
- **4** 7 across minus 3 down
- **6** 14 across divided by eight
- 7 Mean of 21 across and 1 across
- 8 A prime number
- **10** Rearranged digits of 11 across
- 11 Four times a prime number
- **12** 17 across plus half of 1 across
- **14** Thirty-three times a square
- 17 19 across reversed19 17 across reversed
- 20 All digits are the same
- 21 Two-thirds of 18 down

Down

- **1** Twice the result of 11 across plus 20 across
- **2** Consecutive digits unordered
- **3** 2 down minus 10 across
- 4 Mean of 10 down and 4 across
- 5 15 down reversed
- **9** 4 down plus 15 down
- **10** 4 across plus 10 across
- 12 Seven times 3 down
- 13 Rearranged digits of 14 across
- 15 Mean of 14 across and 21 across
- 16 Twice the result of 5 down plus 18 down
- **18** 13 down divided by five
