Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.

- Mean of 7 across and 10 across
- A prime number
- Forty-seven times 9 down
- Twice a prime number
- 10 across divided by eighty-four
