
Cross Figure - Beginner Puzzle #49

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- **1** Twenty-one times a prime number
- **2** Nine times a prime number
- 5 Two hundred nine more than 4 down
- **7** Ten times a prime number
- **10** Thirty less than 11 across
- 11 Fifteen times 8 down

Down

- 1 Twice a prime number
- **3** A prime number
- 4 Mean of 7 across and 10 across
- **5** A prime number
- **6** Forty-seven times 9 down
- **8** Twice a prime number
- **9** 10 across divided by eighty-four
