

# **Cross Figure - Beginner Puzzle #50**

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

#### **Rules:**

- 1. "Words" may not start with a zero.
- 2. "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- 3. There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- 4. Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



### Across

- 1 9 down plus half of 2 down
- **4** Thirteen times a prime number
- **5** 5 down divided by eleven
- **6** Half of 7 down, then subtract 5 down
- **8** 10 across minus half of 11 down
- 10 Two-thirds of 12 down
- 11 Six times a square
- **13** Thirty-five times a square

### **Down**

- 1 Twice a prime number
- **2** Mean of 7 down and 8 across
- **3** A prime number
- **5** Eleven times a prime number
- **7** Thirty-two times 10 across
- **9** Three times a prime number
- **11** Four times a prime number
- **12** 1 down minus 5 across
