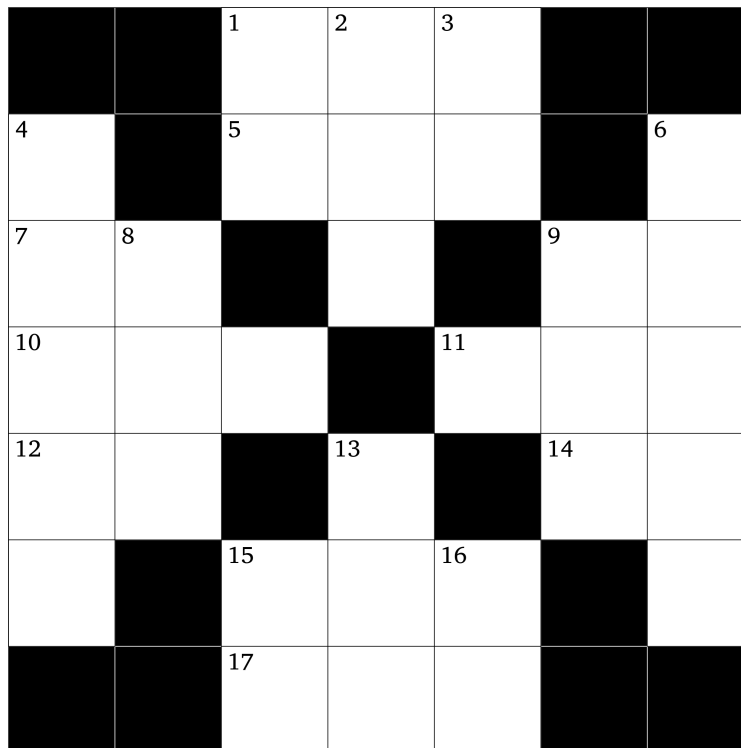


CrossFigure - Challenging Puzzle #6

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- Nine times a prime number
- Mean of 8 down and 9 across
- 9 across minus 15 down
- Mean of 16 down and 14 across
- Twenty-two times 15 down
- 4 down divided by thirty-four
- Half of 13 down, then subtract 10 across
- All digits are the same
- Seven times a prime number
- Twenty-five times a prime number

Down

- Twice the result of 16 down plus 15 down
- A prime number
- 6 down divided by 15 across
- Sixty-eight times a prime number
- Last two digits are the same as last two digits of 4 down
- 13 down plus 16 down
- 2 down minus 7 across
- Twice a prime number
- A prime number
- Three times a prime number
