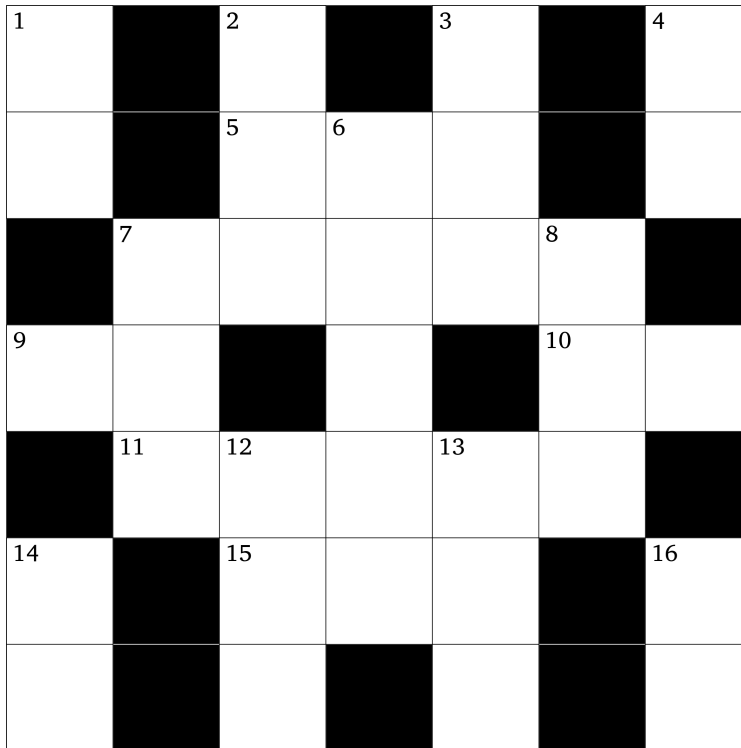


## CrossFigure - Challenging Puzzle #37

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

### Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



### Across

- 5 3 down minus 14 down
- 7 Forty-six times a prime number
- 9 7 across minus half of 11 across
- 10 A prime number
- 11 Five times a square
- 15 14 down plus half of 16 down

### Down

- 1 8 down divided by twenty-one
- 2 All digits are the same
- 3 Mean of 8 down and 4 down
- 4 Twice 10 across
- 6 Eight times a prime number
- 7 12 down minus 2 down
- 12 Five times a prime number
- 13 Mean of 5 across and 1 down
- 14 Mean of 16 down and 9 across
- 16 13 down minus 15 across
