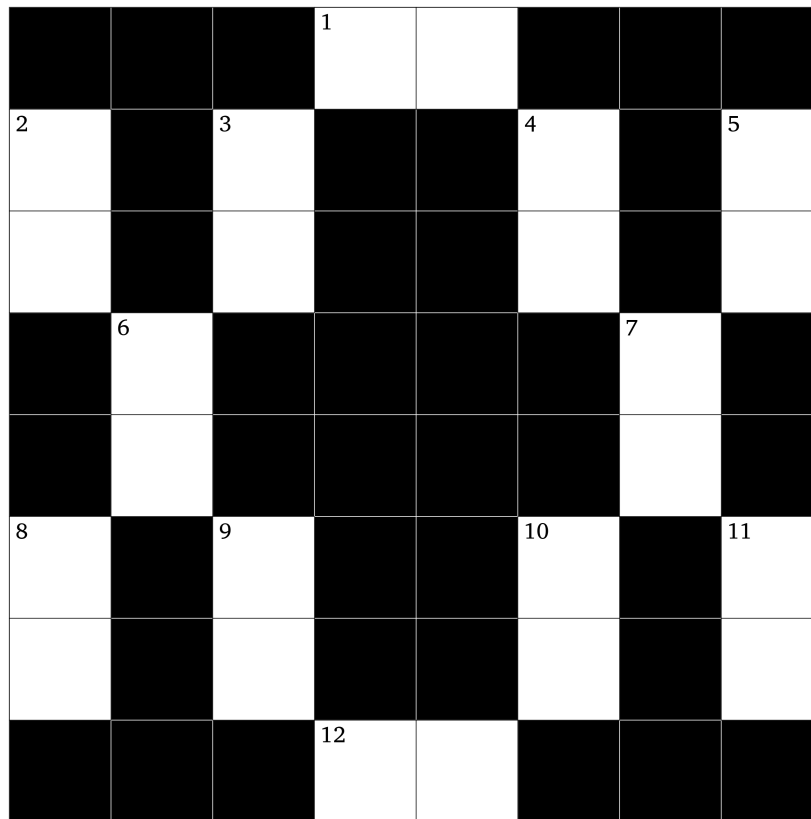


CrossFigure - Intermediate Puzzle #6

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a square and can be a part of a "word" in the across and down directions.

Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" read from left to right and top to bottom.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



Across

- 1** Three times a prime number
12 1 across plus half of 2 down

Down

- 2** Consecutive digits in descending order
3 Mean of 5 down and 6 down
4 5 down reversed
5 Mean of 12 across and 9 down
6 Twice 11 down
7 Three-fourths of 2 down
8 Three-fourths of 10 down
9 Mean of 4 down and 10 down
10 5 down plus 4 down
11 8 down minus 7 down
