

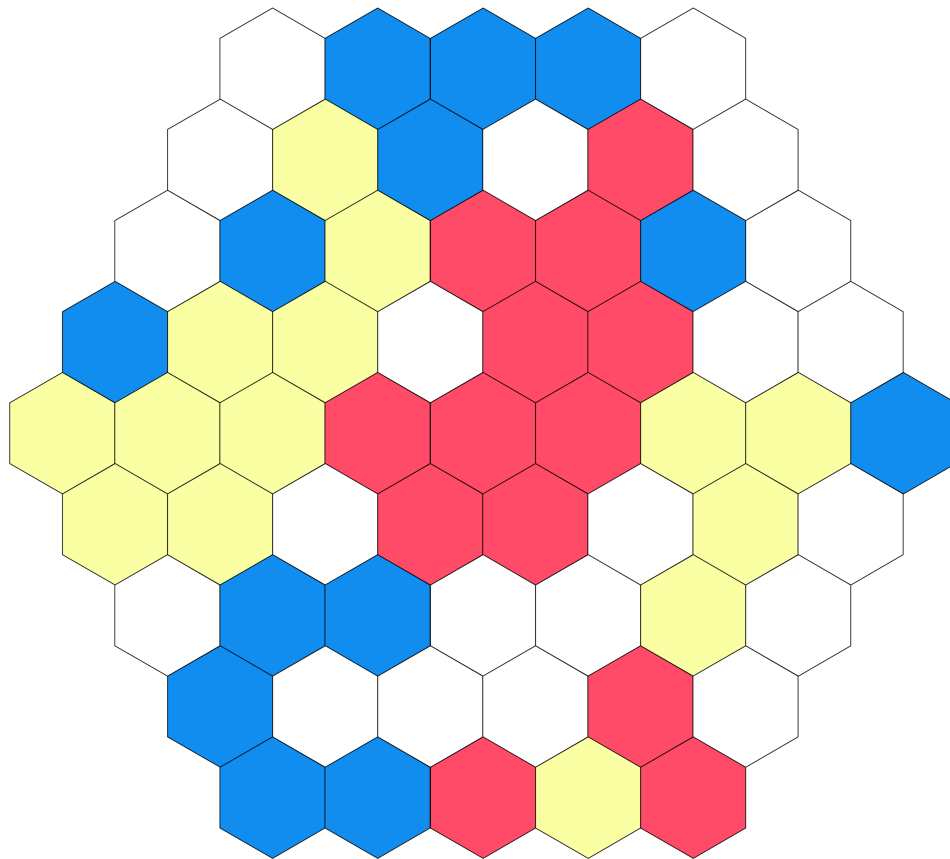
Difficulty: ☆☆☆☆☆

Tri-Color Hex - Beginner Puzzle #42

Color the white cells blue, red, or yellow.

Rules:

1. For every cell, its neighbors must not all have the same color (The color of the cell itself is not relevant for this rule).
2. There must be exactly 6 groups of connected same-color cells.
3. The groups must have exactly 5, 6, 9, 10, 15, and 16 cells.
4. The puzzle has a unique solution.



Solution:
