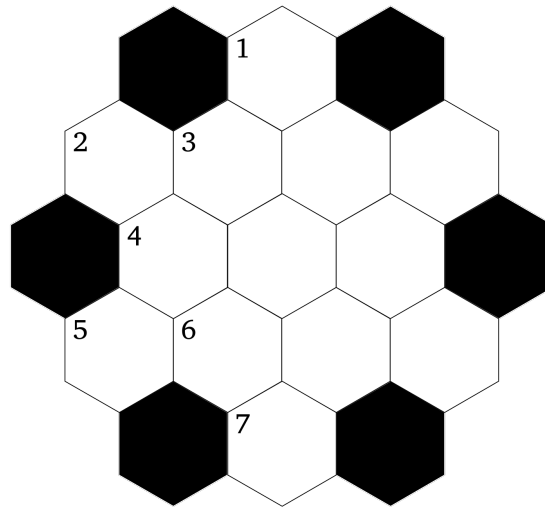


# TripleCross - Intermediate Puzzle #20

This puzzle is like a crossword, but with numbers. Each digit occupies a hexagonal cell and can be a part of a "word" in the across, up, and down directions.

## Rules:

- "Words" may not start with a zero.
- "Words" in the 'across' direction read from left to right.
- "Words" in the 'up' direction read along the upward diagonal to the right.
- "Words" in the 'down' direction read along the downward diagonal to the right.
- There is one unique solution which satisfies all the clues given below.
- Some "words" may not have clues. They will be determined by the "words" which intersect them.



### Across

- 2 2 down minus half of 6 up
- 4 Fifteen times a square
- 5 7 up minus 3 down

### Up

- 5 A prime number
- 6 Four times a prime number
- 7 A prime number

### Down

- 1 Five times a prime number
- 2 Fifty-seven times a square
- 3 Four times a prime number
